Full-time IUP students generally have a total of 160 classroom contact hours per 8-week module, or 320 hours per semester. In order to facilitate conversion of academic credit by U.S. universities, IUP assigns one unit of academic credit for each 20 hours of class time, up to four units (80 hours) for "core" courses, i.e. **IUP202 Second-Year Chinese** through **IUP402/505 Fourth-Year Chinese**. Hours and credit units in excess of 80 / 4 are assigned to our **IUP496/505 Topics in Chinese Studies** course. All class work scores are averaged to determine grades for "core" courses, here shown in bold typeface and larger type.
